Reading Assignment: **New Testament**
1 Timothy 4-6

Put our hope in the living God (4:10)
Rebuke (5:1)

Questions:

3. Why is Paul so worried about wrong doctrine creeping into Timothy’s church?

4. What does 1 Timothy 5:4-8 tell us about taking care of our families?

5. What does the phrase “Do not muzzle the ox while it is treading out the grain” mean (5:18)?

6. In chapter 6 verse 11 Paul tells Timothy to pursue what?

7. What should people who are rich avoid (6:17)?
