# **Children's Ministry Director**

**Job Summary:** The Children's Ministry Director is responsible for overseeing and coordinating all aspects of the children's ministry (ages 4 through 5<sup>th</sup> grade) within Adventure Life Church ("ALC"). This role involves creating a safe, nurturing, and engaging environment for children to learn about and grow in their faith. The Director of Children's Ministry will collaborate with ALC Staff, volunteers, parents, ALC Preschool Staff and church leadership to develop and implement a comprehensive children's ministry program. The selected candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Have a passion and vision for children's ministry and see families grow in their faith together.
- Possess the ability to communicate, plan, delegate, organize and lead effectively.
- Have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, evidenced by action, attitude and behavior.
- Competency with basic computer software (Microsoft Suite, other church tools) and the capacity to learn new software.
- Is a member or will become a member of Adventure Life Church within six months of employment and embraces our mission, vision and values.

## **Key Responsibilities:**

#### 1. Spiritual Leadership:

- Provide spiritual leadership to children by modeling Christian values and principles.
- Develop and deliver age-appropriate biblical teachings and lessons.

#### 2. Program Development:

- Design and implement a well-rounded curriculum that includes Bible studies, worship, and age-appropriate activities.
- Plan and organize events, activities, and outings and align to the SEP School District calendar.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Participate in Leadership Meetings as required.
- Conduct an annual review of Children's Ministry processes and procedures and update where needed.
- Prepare all volunteer materials, crafts and games for Adventure Club, Adventure Kids and Vacation Bible School.
- Plan and coordinate Nursery schedule and care; serve in this ministry once per quarter and as needed thereafter.
- Fill and organize Children's Activity Bags as needed.
- Plan and coordinate the Children's Christmas Program with other staff members and volunteers.
- Plan and organize two service events.
- Participate in one community event per year (ex. Altoona-Palooza, National Night Out, Homecoming Parade).
- Plan annual Volunteer appreciation event.
- Work closely with the Youth Pastor to assure smooth transition of students to youth ministry.
- Publish Children's Ministry events in the church app calendar.

## 3. Volunteer Recruitment and Training:

- Recruit, train, and equip volunteers to serve in various capacities within the children's ministry.
- Serve as backup teacher when needed.
- Conduct background checks and ensure volunteers meet safety and training requirements.

### 4. Safety and Security:

- Establish and maintain a safe and secure environment for children.
- Implement safety policies and procedures, including check-in/check-out systems and emergency protocols.
- Create documentation for safety procedures and share with staff and volunteers.

## 5. Parent and Community Engagement:

- Foster open communication with parents, keeping them informed about the children's ministry's activities and progress.
- Organize parent meetings and events to build a supportive community.

### 6. Budget Management:

- Develop and manage the Children's Ministry budget, including allocating resources for curriculum materials, supplies, and events.
- Seek approval from Leadership for any purchases that exceed the established Children's Ministry budget.

#### 7. Outreach and Growth:

- Develop strategies to reach out to new families and engage them in the Children's Ministry.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the Children's Ministry program and make improvements as needed. Present ministry results to Leadership on a quarterly basis.

### 8. Team Leadership:

• Lead and support a team of volunteers and staff members, including recruiting, training, and conducting regular team meetings.

#### 9. Administrative Tasks:

- Maintain accurate records of attendance, volunteers, ministry materials, and resources.
- Handle administrative tasks such as scheduling, communication, and ministry promotion.

## **Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's degree in a related field (theology, education, child development, etc.) preferred but not required.
- Strong personal commitment to Christian faith and values.
- Experience working with children in a ministry or educational setting.
- Leadership and organizational skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to collaborate with volunteers and parents.
- Knowledge of child safety and security best practices.
- Proficiency in using relevant software and tools for administration and communication.
